### BASIC NEEDS

♦Towels ♦Wash clothes ♦Blankets ♦Food ♦Tarps ♦Sheets

### HEALTH KITS

Health kits contain specific items:

- 1 hand towel (15"x 25" to 17"x 27")
- 1 wash cloth
- 1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket size)
- 1 nail file or finger nail clipper (no emery boards or toe-nail clippers)
- 1 bath size bar of soap
- 1 toothbrush (single brush in original wrapper; not child-sized)
- 1 large tube of toothpaste
- 6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages
- \* All items should be placed inside a sealed one gallon plastic bag. No money, notes, religious or political literature, or other items should be placed in kits.
