Placement testing is required of all new students and must be taken prior to the start of the summer school session in which you wish to enroll. After you have completed the placement testing process, you will be allowed to register for the classes that you wish to take. If you are unable to come to a placement testing session prior to the start of summer school, you will be tested and registered on the first day of the appropriate session.
